OPEN SESSIONS

PARENTS MEETINGS

SATs

Following the Government's response to the <u>consultation on primary assessment</u>, the DfE announced that assessments at the end of KS1 would become non-statutory from the academic year 2023 to 2024. This means that the SATS assessments are no longer a statutory requirement but the school will use the optional KS1 Assessments as part or our continuous Teacher Assessments and this will help to inform end of year judgements. Parents will receive an annual end of year report as usual to report information regarding their child's progress at the end of year 2.

ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL DUE TO ILLNESS OR LATENESS

May we remind parents/carers that it is your responsibility to inform school by telephone if your child is absent, during the first morning your child is absent for any reason including illness. Failure to contact school may result in absences being recorded in the register as unauthorised and could be considered as a failure to secure regular school attendance.

Children can arrive at school from 8.45am and must be supervised closely by parents/carers in the playground until the school day starts at 8.55am. Please ensure the children stay off the grass, wooden activity trail and garden areas and encourage them to play sensibly whilst waiting to come into school.

If your child arrives at school after 9.05am they will receive a late mark and you must sign them into school at the main office. Lateness to school can be unsettling for children and disruptive for the class.

PARKING

As always parking around the school can be difficult, but please be respectful to our residents and park responsibly. Try to walk where possible or set off a little earlier and park further away from congested areas.
