Please note: If you wish your child to change from dinners to pack-ups could you please notify the school office with 2 weeks' notice.

PARKING

We have had a lot of issues with irresponsible parking this term and the police have been involved. Please be respectful to all members of the public when parking outside resident's properties and around the wider area of the school, ensure that you don't block driveways or within the no parking zone around school.

REMINDER The two staff carparks are for staff and deliveries only, Parents should not use these carparks unless they have a blue badge and the named person on the badge is in the vehicle. **Please also be aware taxis are also not allowed to use these carparks**.

PARENT/CARER CONTACT DETAILS

It is your responsibility to inform the office of **any changes to addresses**, **telephone numbers and emergency contacts** so that we can hold up to date information of where we can contact you in case of an emergency. We no longer print out data collections sheets for you to update.

SAFEGUARDING

To ensure our children's safety and to remove any risks, please do not leave young children or babies unattended in your car, whilst you drop off or collect other children from school.

The Head teacher, Mrs T Bass is the designated person responsible for child protection and safeguarding.

ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL DUE TO ILLNESS OR LATENESS

May we remind parents/carers that it is your responsibility to inform school by telephone or through the parent email address (parents@bushfieldinfants.co.uk) if your child is absent. Do not use Tapestry or class Dojo for reporting absence. Please contact school on the first morning your child is absent for any reason including illness. Failure to contact school may result in absences being recorded in the register as unauthorised and could be considered as a failure to secure regular school attendance.

Persistent absenteeism is currently 28% which still much higher than the national figure at 15%. Attendance below 90% is classed as persistent absence and this means your **child missing 19** or **more days during the academic year**. Good attendance is vital for the success of pupils and their wellbeing. Poor attendance results in poorer outcomes for children.
